



**INFORMATION CLAUSE ABOUT PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA DUE TO ACT
OF LAWS**

Przemysłowy Instytut Motoryzacji (PIMOT) with headquarters in Warsaw near Jagiellońska 55 Street, 03 - 301 Warszawa (further called: „PIMOT”) is processing data included in the price offers or proposals about proceedings in public inquiry being in publicly available register (Krajowy Rejestr Sądowy, Centralna Ewidencja i Informacja o Działalności Gospodarczej RP, Krajowy Rejestr Karny) in order to conduct public procurement proceedings on the basis of the provisions of the Act of 29 January 2004 Public Procurement Law (Dz. U. z 2017 r. poz. 1579, z późn. zm.). This information may include data based on the Regulation of the European Parliament and the Council of the European Union 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and the repeal of Directive 95 / 46 / EC (hereinafter: "General Regulation" or "GDPR"), have the nature of personal data.

PIMOT informs that:

1. The Administrator of your personal data is Director of Przemysłowy Instytut Motoryzacji PIMOT, Jagiellońska 55 St., 03-301 Warszawa, tel. 22 7777 015, instytut@pimot.eu.
2. You can contact the inspector of personal data protection appointed by the administrator of your personal data by writing to the address ul. Jagiellońska 55, 03-301 Warszawa, tel. 667 021 000, l.janek@pimot.eu.
3. Personal data contained in offers are processed on the basis of art. 6 par. 1 lit. c GDPR, i.e. processing is necessary to fulfill the legal obligation of the administrator. The purpose of processing personal data is to conduct public procurement proceedings. Processing of personal data for the needs of the above proceedings falls within the scope of PIMOT's statutory activities. The processing of this data is necessary for PIMOT to properly perform the duties imposed on it.

The initiation of the proceedings leads to the fact that there is a documentation regarding this procedure, which we are obliged to keep for a certain period of time. Therefore, we will process your data for archiving in the public interest pursuant to art. 6 par. 1 lit. c) GDPR to meet the obligation set out in art. 5 para. 1 and art. 34 par. 1 point 1 from the Act of 14 July 1983 on the national archival resources.

It is also conceivable that hypothetical, public entities will turn to us for the transfer of your personal data collected in the proceedings - for example, courts or prosecutors - for whom we will have a legal obligation to provide them with data - here the basis for data processing will also be art. 6 par. 1 lit. c) GDPR.

4. The recipient of your personal data will be employees authorized by PIMOT. They can also be other public entities - for example, courts or prosecutors, administrative bodies that will contact us with an appropriate request for access to data, and the law obliges us to implement

it. The application for access to archival materials may also be addressed to other entities, including natural persons - but if we do not have a legal obligation to provide them with archival materials regarding you, possible disclosure will take place only for your consent, which we will ask for in separate correspondence.

5. Your personal data would be kept for a period of:

1) 4 years from the date of completion of the public procurement procedure,

2) if the duration of the contract exceeds 4 years – for the entire duration of the contract.

6. You have the right to access your personal data and the right to rectify, delete, limit processing, the right to transfer data, the right to object to the processing.

7. You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory body when you feel that the processing of your personal data concerning you violates the provisions of the GDPR.

8. Providing personal data by you is a statutory requirement. You are obliged to provide them, and the consequence of not providing personal data will be the inability to evaluate offers and conclude a contract.

9. Data shared by you will not be subjected to profiling and automated processing
